#DigitalCheckNRW now in English - test your digital knowledge in different languages

The #DigitalCheckNRW has been expanded in many ways and can now also be executed in English. Other languages such as Turkish and Arabic will follow.

North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW) is the most populous federal state in Germany and the people who live here communicate in many different languages. The self-test was translated into English in order to reflect this diversity and to provide access to digital knowledge for everyone in NRW. In the future, there will also be a Turkish and an Arabic version, which can be selected at www.digitalcheck.nrw.

The state government's #DigitalCheckNRW is an easily accessible and free-of-charge online self-test. Users can find out about their digital knowledge and strengthen their own media skills. The self-test not only presents the personal level of knowledge, but also offers interesting background information and provides suitable further training programs – locally or online.

#DigitalCheckNRW is a project of the Society for Media Education and Communication Culture (GMK) e.V. and is funded by the Prime Minister of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia. The self-test is based on the Medienkompetenzrahmen NRW – the proven media skills framework North Rhine-Westphalia. This has been developed for schools and has now been extended for adults to promote lifelong learning.
